The EQLS serves as a rich source of information about contemporary European societies, relevant for both research and policy communities. Quality of life clearly embraces a wide range of policy areas, with a particular need to map and understand disparities associated with age, gender, health, social class and region.
- I worked in the development of a new module that the 2016 EQLS will include on health and care services, covering healthcare, long-term care, childcare and education, and focusing on access, use and quality of the services.
- I collaborated in the project “The Gender Employment Gap: Challenges and Solutions”. In particular with a chapter on the social effects of the women’s participation in the labour market.

- I participated in the development of the Gender Equality Index. One of the first stages was to map the main gender equality issues within the frame of EU policy in order to identify the key areas of interest and to develop the conceptual framework of the Index. This phase allowed to defined six core domains - work, money, time, power, knowledge and health – and two satellite domains, intersecting inequalities and violence. All of them were theoretically defined and based on the policy priorities. International and harmonized data sources were scrutinized in order to find quality data to populate those domains. In particular, the domain of violence presented a significant lack of data to cover the different forms of gender-based violence, despite the efforts done by FRA, UN and Eurostat.
- I contributed to the project entitled “Information on the efforts made by the governments of EU Member States in the equality field” which aimed to develop the country profiles to contextualize the index’s results, providing an overview of the policy initiatives for the promotion of gender equality at

national level, supporting decision-makers and researchers in interpreting the results of the Gender Equality Index and in drawing conclusions to feed into national and EU level debates on closing the gender equality gap. All this work allowed me to accumulate a very detailed knowledge of gender equality policies.

- My contribution to the Index project was also focused on the development of the methodology applied as well as on data collection and data mining for the construction of the Index. As applied statistician, I have a good knowledge of several European surveys and data and my work is mainly based on the analysis of these sources and the development of indicators, from the methodological to the empirical point of view.
- I was collaborating in the initial phase of the development of the EIGE's database on gender statistics, which contains harmonised data at the EU level, internationally comparable data from sources such as Eurostat, DG Justice and Consumers, Eurofound and FRA. Among the criteria used in the structure of the database the key EU policy areas and the EU strategies were considered.

I have a long and considerable experience of managing and conducting projects at national and European level. This has also included the coordination of a team of interdisciplinary researchers (6 members), as the research manager of the Research Group "Socio-Economic Diversity". As part of my role, I have demonstrated good managerial and organizational skills, good ability of coordinating multiple small teams and managing budget. I have also shown to be capable to successfully operate on several transversal and multidisciplinary projects.
 During my more than 18 years of experience in research I have organized several seminars and conferences, promoting dialogue on relevant topics of Social Sciences with people from different sectors (academy, public administration, companies). In this regard, I was a member of the organizing and scientific committees of the "Fifth International Conference on History of Statistics and Probability" (2009 and 2011) and the "International Congress on Social Diversity" (2012, 2014 and 2016).

Overall I have more than 15 years of work experience in teaching and researching, in five different EU Member States. My main fields of interest are connected to social sciences: applied statistics, quality of life, diversity, socio-economic indices, and gender sensitive indicators.

In relation with those fields I frequently act as a referee for different academic journals such as: Social Indicators Research, Estadística Española, Estudios de Economía Aplicada, The International Journal of Interdisciplinary Social Sciences and the International Atlantic Economic Review.

My research has been based on the analysis of the main socio-economic data bases at national and international level, applying several statistical methods in order to synthesize large amount of information: descriptive analysis, multivariate analysis (factor analysis, principal component analysis, cluster analysis, discriminant analysis, correspondence analysis, variance analysis, etc.), modeling and estimation (regression, parametric and non-parametric), inference methods and survey sample design.

As applied statistician, I have a very good knowledge of data collection and the main European surveys, above all with the following sources: Eurostat, Eurofound, FRA, EC, UN, OECD. Additionally, my experience at Eurostat (2006), Eurofound (2010, 2015-2016) and EIGE (2012-2014) has given me a good knowledge of EU institutions and policies. In particular I am knowledgeable about the EU strategies for gender equality, including policies at European level and national action plans. Moreover I am familiar with the DG Employment initiatives for integration of women in the labour market, such as the Employment package, and with the Policy Roadmap provided to facilitate the 2014 implementation of the Social Investment Package in Member States and to help them reaching the Europe 2020 strategy goals.
